




WEST BUILDING



NORTH BUILDING | THIRD FLOOR




NORTH BUILDING | FOURTH FLOOR




SOUTH BUILDING

THIRD FLOOR





Reservations and Registration

The National Conference Center's reservations policy: Our reservations staff makes every effort to accommodate your requests, however early check-ins and late check-outs cannot always be guaranteed. Please review the following and ask your conference planning manager any questions you may have.

Prior to Arrival

There are six floors of guest rooms in the North and South Buildings. Suites and handicapped-accessible rooms must be reserved in advance.

Please use the rooming list and/or the secured online Passkey site set up for your group to submit the names of all guests attending the conference. Guests not requiring overnight accommodations are referred to as "Day Guests." Guarantees for day guests (for each meeting day) are required three business days prior to the first meeting day.



Upon Arrival

Check-in: 5:00 PM, Check-out: 1:00 PM


All guests are required to provide a valid credit card number upon arrival. This covers all purchases, room incidentals, and activates telephone service in the guest rooms. Local-area calls are no charge, metro area calls are 75 cents each and long distance calls are charged at the AT&T daytime operator assisted rates, 24 hours a day.

Guest badges will be provided to all guests at check-in or by your planning manager. The badges must be worn for entrance into the dining room as a guest identifier. Arrangements can be made with your planning manager to design customized badges for an additional fee.





Parking for day commuters is available in Lots A and B. Free shuttle service is provided from our parking lot to the lobby. For commuters with hybrid vehicles, reserved parking spots are located in the lot near the entrance of the West building. The schedule below is for the parking shuttle only:

DC's Wine Country®

Towns and Villages, Heritage and Recreation

Discover what Loudoun County has to offer. As a destination full of character, your group can experience early American history or take in the beautiful scenic breathtaking views, all within minutes from the Conference Center. No matter your interests, Loudoun County has something fun to offer you.



Rich in American heritage, the seven towns and numerous villages of Loudoun have friendliness and charm that offers the perfect escape from life's everyday routine. Loudoun is home to National Historic Landmarks, annual fairs and festivals and Civil War sites. Each town has a pleasant streetscape unveiling its history. Loudoun's most popular visitor destinations are the town of Leesburg, the county seat, and Middleburg, the unofficial capital of horse country.



Heritage

In our backyard lies the history of America. Loudoun County is in the center of The Journey Through Hallowed Ground, a 180-mile scenic and historic corridor stretching from Jefferson's Monticello near Charlottesville, Virginia, to Gettysburg, Pennsylvania.

Today, 19th-century plantations and Civil War battlefields still exist in Loudoun for visitors to touch a piece of America's history. In Leesburg, Morven Park is a 1,000-acre estate that was the home of a Virginia governor. It features a Greek Revival-style mansion, the Museum of Hounds and Hunting, a horse-drawn carriage collection, recreated Civil War camp and boxwood gardens. Ball's Bluff Battlefield is the site of the second largest Civil War battle fought in Loudoun and features a one-mile hiking trail loop with interpretive signs and a national cemetery.



Recreation and Golfing

The great outdoors of Loudoun County is waiting for you to take advantage of what it has to offer. Hike scenic parks, bike the old W&OD trail, which is now a 45-mile paved multi-use recreational trail, go horseback riding or just take in some fresh air.

Bring your passion and awaken your game to the holes of championship golf in Loudoun, where many courses are designed by golf professionals like Greg Norman and Gary Player. Enjoy gorgeous scenery and pro-golf shops with experienced professionals.
